## RESOLUTIONS OF SOLIDARITY

### SOLIDARITY WITH CUBA

→ For forty five years and as part of their systematic policy of hostility and aggression, ten successive US Administrations have applied a cruel economic, financial and commercial blockade on Cuba, a blockade that has been intensified under the present Republican Administration of President George W. Bush. Up to now, it has caused economic damages that amount to \$ 82.764 billion, a total figure that does not include more than \$ 54 billion imputed to direct damage caused to Cuba's economic and social objectives by acts of sabotage and terrorism stimulated and funded from the United States.

The policy of the US blockade - whose main objective is to destroy the Cuban Revolution and impose US colonial domination on the island, an ambition clearly stated in the so-called Bush's Plan for the Annexation of Cuba - qualifies as an act of genocide and a violation of the principles of international law. And, as an evidence of the isolation of this criminal policy of the US Administration, the international community has expressed its increasing and almost unanimous rejection of the US blockade by voting - for 14 consecutive years - in favour of the resolution that Cuba presents to the United Nations General Assembly to demand the end of the US blockade.

However, in addition to this act of interference, the US Government is also involved in the organization, support and funding of terrorist activities against Cuba

and, as a consequence, the Cuban people have mourned the loss of more than 3 478 human lives.

One of the most atrocious crimes committed against that nation was the mid-flight blowing-up of a Cuban civil aircraft in October 1976, a terrorist action that caused the death of all the 73 people on board. The mastermind behind that horrendous crime was the notorious terrorist and self-confessed criminal Luis Posada Carriles. Nowadays the Bush Administration refuses to extradite him to Venezuela, thus violating international as well as US laws.

And while it supports and protects this kind of terrorists, five courageous young Cubans: Antonio, Fernando, Gerardo, Ramón and René - who were risking their lives every day in the struggle against terrorism - were unjustly condemned to serve long sentences in prison as a result of a fraudulently rigged trial that was turned into a political vendetta against the Cuban Revolution.

The cause of the Cuban Five has brought about a growing movement of solidarity in the world and there are already thousands of voices that are demanding their immediate release and that the real terrorists, who are freely walking by Miami streets, to be brought to justice.

On May 27, 2005, the Working Group on Arbitrary Detentions of the United Nations Commission on Human Rights declared that the imprisonment of the

five Cuban anti-terrorist fighters is arbitrary and illegal and urged the US Government to release them. More recently, on August 9, the 11<sup>th</sup> Circuit of the Atlanta Court of Appeals handed down the unanimous ruling of three of its judges revoking the sentences and annulling the rigged trial of the Cuban Five in Miami. Since they are innocent of the crimes they were accused, this would imply their immediate release.

However, while the Cuban Five are still kidnapped, harassed and punished in US maximum-security prisons, in the case of the notorious Cuban-born terrorist Luis Posada Carriles, the US Government insists in obstructing the course of justice and does nothing to stop the unpunished terrorist actions of the Miami Cuban-American mafia.

The kidnapping of the Cuban Five and the US Government's complicity with the notorious terrorist Luis Posada Carriles are an evidence of the immorality that

characterizes the Government of George W. Bush, who is seeking to set himself as the leader of the international campaign against terrorism, a campaign that has been turned into a new crusade against the Third World peoples' right to sovereignty and self-determination.

For all the above-mentioned reasons, we, the Communist and workers' parties gathered here today, demand the immediate release of the five Cuban young heroes who have been kidnapped for seven years in US prisons, as well as the end of the genocidal US blockade imposed for 45 years on the heroic Cuban people.

Likewise, we express our deep rejection of all terrorist acts committed in every form and against any people in the world, including state terrorism like the one waged against the Cuban people, and also demand the extradition and trial of terrorist Luis Posada Carriles in Venezuela.

## SOLIDARITY WITH VENEZUELA

→ Today, the people of Venezuela, the heir of the emancipating ideas of Simón Bolívar, El Libertador, is the protagonist of a revolution, led by President Hugo Chávez Frías, that is a hope for that nation and for all the peoples of Latin America.

In the last few years, in spite of facing the constant aggressions of US imperialism and the destabilizing and subversive activity of an internal opposition that has been defeated in the ten popular referendums held up to now, the triumphant Bolivarian Revolution can show a vast social work that has benefited millions of citizens who used to live sunk into poverty and neglect.

As part of the numerous programs that are being carried out by the Bolivarian Revolution, last October Venezuela declared itself as a Territory Free of Illiteracy and 1.5 million Venezuelans learned how to read and write. Many of them are studying now in higher educational levels. The health system has been extended to the whole country, thus benefiting over 17 million people who were totally excluded earlier from this elementary social service that is being expanded now with the improvement of public hospitals and the construction of new health facilities. Unemployment has decreased considerably and a wide network of markets has been opened so that 12 million people can buy staple food at low prices.

Notwithstanding the strong resistance of the local bourgeoisie and the

landowners, the implementation of the Act of the Land is making progress. Hundreds of thousands of hectares have been recovered and are being allotted among thousands of families. The country works speedily to expand its road infrastructure, its industrial development and its agricultural self-sufficiency. Oil, the main export commodity of the Venezuelan economy, is really state-owned now and its earnings are mainly allotted for the country's development and social programs.

In the international arena, President Chávez promotes the Bolivarian Alternative for the Americas (ALBA), a project for the integration of Latin America, on the basis of solidarity, social justice and cooperation, that is being implemented in the relations between Cuba and Venezuela and is present in the agreements signed with other South American and Caribbean nations.

As part of the ALBA, the governments of Venezuela and Cuba have approved a program so that, in the next ten years, six million Latin American and Caribbean people will receive ophthalmologic health care, while two hundred thousand students from this region will receive free training as doctors who will be willing to provide health services for the excluded and marginalized people, who are the vast majorities of the population in the region.

For all the above-mentioned reasons, the Bolivarian Revolution is an example

248 for the peoples of the region and of all the Third World because it is carrying out an alternative program to the poverty, neglect, inequality and injustice sown in the region by the neo-liberal model brutally applied by imperialism.

The process promoted by President Hugo Chávez and his efforts to attain regional unity and integration create new conditions for facing the policy of domination and annexation that has characterized the relations of the USA with the continent and the neo-fascist projection of the present US Administration.

All these factors determine the media campaign that is being carried out by US imperialism with the aim of presenting the Bolivarian process and President Chávez as evil, the constant threats

uttered by the main leaders of the ultra-right in that country and the activity of subversion and the support provided by the special agencies of the Empire and the Miami mob to the internal counter-revolution. In the face of this situation, the Venezuelan people are increasingly and firmly determined to defend their right to sovereignty, self-determination and to the construction of a future of dignity and equality for their nation.

We, the Communist and workers' parties gathered here in Athens, Greece, express our rejection of the present US Administration's policy of aggressions against the Bolivarian Revolution and reaffirm our solidarity with the struggle of the noble and courageous people of Venezuela.

# Press release



73 communist and workers' parties from all continents met in Athens from the 18<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2005 at the International Meeting of Communist and Workers' Parties, with the topic "*Current Trends in Capitalism. Economic, Political and Social Impact. The communists' alternative.*"

Several parties, who could not attend, sent greetings and written contributions, which form part of the documents of the conference. Over the three days of the conference there was a creative exchange of views concerning the international situation and experiences on the questions of work in the mass movements, the struggle of the peoples and the activities of the communist and workers' parties. Solidarity statements around a broad scope of international issues were proposed and adopted by the participants.

The speakers referred to contemporary phenomena and tendencies in capitalism. It was noted the imperialist aggressiveness in all spheres and the assault on the social and labour rights. Experiences were exchanged concerning the movements and struggles of the peoples in the different conditions of the various countries and the role of communists in them. The discussion highlighted the timeliness of socialism and views were exchanged on the ways to project and promote this goal in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

It was noted that it is necessary to develop active political solidarity and support among Communist and Workers' Parties, and more generally among popular movements and there views were exchanged on possible forms of joint action.

Participants expressed the need for similar meetings to continue and multiply at an inter-
